SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION – PART II

Instructions

Please submit the following items along with the Application Part I and your non-refundable fee of \$25. *Please note: All documents must be submitted by the deadline (March 31, 2022) for the application to be considered.*

1. A personal narrative of no more than 750 words that describes your culture, and how it has shaped who you are and what you do (e.g. your performance in high school [include your GPA], leadership roles, and community engagement) as well as how it has inspired your **career choice**. This essay must be typed and double-spaced.
2. Three Letters of Recommendation. A Guidance Counselor must provide one of these letters. All Letters of Recommendation must be emailed to Mrs. Mylene Matthews-Manzano at mmatthews19@carolina.rr.com **AND** Dr. Monique Constance-Huggins at hugginsm@winthrop.edu
3. A list of Colleges that you have applied to or have been accepted to. If accepted, please enclose a copy of each acceptance letter.

Application Procedure

The CICA, Inc. Scholarship Program is reserved for high school seniors of West Indian descent who are highly motivated and intend to pursue undergraduate degrees full-time. The program was developed by CICA, Inc. to provide financial assistance to students in the United States of Caribbean descent.

Established in 2002, the Program is funded by a combination of fund-raising events and donations. The Program will further CICA's goal of uniting the Charlotte Community and the Caribbean Community through scholarships, mentoring, and volunteerism.

GUIDLINES

Each year, a total amount of \$2,500.00 will be awarded to a maximum of five (5) students with each student receiving a minimum of \$500.00. The recipients may use the funds toward any college-related financial obligations during their first year in College. CICA Scholarships are not limited to any specific field or career objectives and may be used to pursue any academic discipline. Several students have received CICA Scholarships since the inception of the Program.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES

SELECTION

The selection process begins when a high school senior submits the application with a \$25.00 non-refundable processing fee. The application must be postmarked by **March 31, 2022**. Each application is carefully considered and evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Completeness of the application
- Quality of the personal narrative
- Academic standing
- Leadership ability
- School and community involvement

A screening committee initially reviews each file before it is submitted to an independent reviewer.

Award recipients are selected in the spring prior to entering college. Applications are screened during the months of February and March and award recipients are notified in April. This year, a virtual ceremony will be held where the scholarship recipients will be recognized and the award of \$500 or more (depending on the number of recipients) will be announced.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

CICA Scholarship applications must be postmarked no later than **March 31, 2022**, of the student's Senior Year of High School. *Please note: All documents must be submitted by the deadline for the application to be considered.*

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

CICA Scholarships may be used towards the costs of tuition, fees, books, room and board, computers, health insurance, general living expenses, and other college-related expenses. Recipients must enroll in and attend an accredited institution in the academic year after their selection and provide verification of enrollment. Scholarship funds are paid directly to the schools and no funds will be dispersed to students directly. All approved recipients must claim their award within one (1) year after being selected.
